All un-entered cattle and those missing their turn in the ballot will be offered for sale at the end of the catalogued entries. *All sucklers must be declared at the time of sale*

No lots can leave the Market without a 'pass out slip' being issued by the main office

Purchasers have two working days from time of sale to satisfy themselves that all documentation received is correct and any discrepancies must be notified to the Auctioneers within that time limit.

Paperwork must accompany livestock and if making multiple loads please make sure that the paperwork is presented with the first load.

TB Status Notification

If you are a 1 year TB test holding, please ensure your cattle have been tested within the 60 days prior to sale date. Please bring a copy of your current TB Test Certificate with your passports and indicate on the blue entry form how many days remain on your current test.

The information given is for guidance purposes only.

Vendors: please ensure all cattle have two Ministry approved ear tags.

Please make sure your stock is forward as early as possible to ensure your stock is lotted and penned as swiftly as possible.

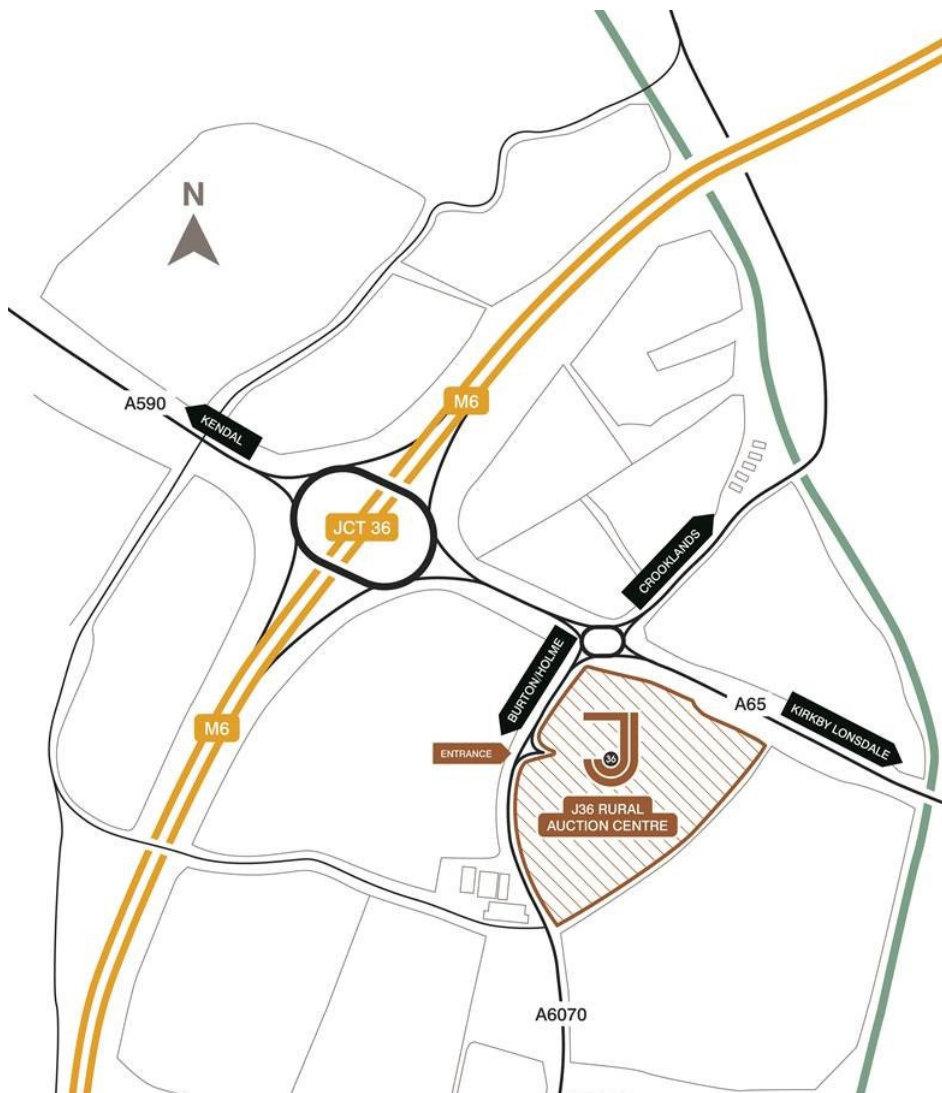
