### Terms & Conditions

- **No single birds or growers accepted. Only breeding sets (pairs, trios, quartets) or sets of pullets. Pair = 1 male & 1 female. Trio = 1 male & 2 females. Quartet = 1 male & 3 females.**
- **NO INDIVIDUAL COCKERELS**
- **EQUIPMENT & HATCHING EGGS TO BE SOLD BEFORE THE POULTRY**
- Please state how many in the set when entering a pen of pullets.
- 12 ½ % Commission or a minimum of £2 per lot will be charged on all lots sold.
- All entries to be advised to the office either verbally or on this entry form by Friday 13th August 2021 so we can arrange cages.
- **Delivery of Poultry is strictly on the day of sale 8:30am-9:30am**
- The Auctioneers reserve the right to refuse entry.
- All legislation relating to fowl pest and the sale/transportation of live poultry will apply.
- Further information regarding the registration and testing of laying flocks can be obtained from the Regional Ministry of Agriculture Veterinary Officer.
- There is no guarantee by the Auctioneers as to the health status of any lot.
- **All birds must be carried in boxes.** No birds shall be carried in sacks.
- **All birds must be provided with an adequate supply of water.**
- All lots are accepted into the Market entirely at the Vendors risk.
- **All Reserves must be with the Auctioneers by 10:00am morning of sale.**
- It is the Vendors responsibility to ensure the Auctioneers have the correct description for the contents of the pen.
- The Auctioneers hold no responsibility for the descriptions collected from the vendors.
- **Upset Price** - there will be an Upset Price of £8 on each lot.
- No VAT on birds
- **All birds must be cleared from the market by 2.30pm on the day of sale.**
- All purchasers and vendors with unsold lots must obtain a receipted 'Pass Out' obtainable from the main office upon settlement of their account. The pass will have to be presented to NWA staff at the time of collection.
- Vendors are responsible for ensuring that all poultry they have forward are sold before leaving the premises.
